

QuestLine Nomination Usability Enhancement

August 2010

The August 2010 update to QuestLine includes usability enhancements to the Nominations Submission screen summarized below. Additional information and screen examples are included in the updated QuickStart on How to Enter or Change a Nomination (Nomination Usability Enhancement August 2010). **A test database will be provided for you to try out these changes prior to the cutover at the end of August.**

Nominations Submission Screen

In the Header Area:

- The beginning Gas Day alone determines the records displayed in the grids.
- The Default End Gas Day is now applied to everything in the grid that is added or changed.
- The Default End Gas Day can be used to highlight which records have material changes or have a value change in a later cycle (after the first open cycle on the day in question).

In the Grid Areas:

- The End Gas Day in the Path, Upstream, and Downstream grids is no longer an enterable field.

Best Practices:

- Once a date range is created and nominations changed, make sure nominations are in balance, submitted, or re-retrieved before changing the date range again. This will help manage the nomination for the specific date range and avoid creating overlapping nominations.
- Once changes have been made with one method, continue with that method until the nominations are submitted.
- To extend a previously submitted nomination through the end of the month, either:
 - Create a new nomination (starting with the day following the last date of the previously submitted nomination, through the end of the month).
 - Or, use the 31 day popup (remember to use only one method per submission).
